AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF EAST CONEMAUGH, CAMBRIA COUNTY, PENNSYLVANIA AUTHORIZING THE ERECTION OF A "DEAF CHILD AREA" SIGNS IN THE 100 BLOCK AREA OF 4TH STREET AND LOCUST STREET IN THE BOROUGH OF EAST CONEMAUGH TO WARN VEHICULAR TRAFFIC TRAVELING ON 4TH STREET IN THE 100 BLOCK AREA OF 4TH STREET OF THE POSSIBLE PRESENCE OF A DEAF CHILD

ORDINANCE NO. 22-02

WHEREAS, the Motor Vehicle Code recognizes that it is a proper exercise of police power for a municipality to regulate traffic traveling on any roads within their municipal boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of East Conemaugh wishes to regulate traffic on traveling on the 100 block of 4th Street from its intersection with Berry Court toward Oak Street by erecting a "DEAF CHILD AREA" sign on 4th Street at its intersection with Berry Court; and

WHEREAS, the Borough of East Conemaugh wishes to regulate traffic on traveling on the 100 block of 4th Street from its intersection with Oak Street toward Berry Court by erecting a "DEAF CHILD AREA" sign on 4th Street at its intersection with Oak Street; and

NOW THEREFORE, the Borough of East Conemaugh hereby ordains the following:

I. AUTHORITY

- A. 75 PA. C.S.A §102 defines "Local authorities" as a county, municipal and other local boards or bodies having authority to enact laws relating to traffic.
- B. 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 6102(b) states that local authorities may exercise the powers granted in Chapter 61 only by duly enacted ordinances of their governing bodies.
- C. 75 Pa. C.S.A. § 6109(a) is titled 'Enumeration of police powers.: and states that the provisions of this title (75) shall not be deemed to prevent ... local authorities on streets or highways within their physical boundaries from the reasonable exercise of their police powers.
- D. 75 Pa. C.S.A. §6109(a)(2) presumes that regulating traffic by means of official traffic-control devices is a reasonable exercise of police power.
- E. 75 Pa. C.S.A. §6109(b)(1) requires any action taken by local authorities under this section (61) shall be by ordinance.
- F. 75 Pa. C.S.A. §6109(b)(1) requires any action taken by local authorities under this section (61) shall be by ordinance

II. SCOPE

- A. To give warning to the flow of vehicular traffic on 4th Street traveling from its intersection with:
 - Berry Court toward Oak Street by erecting a "DEAF CHILD AREA" sign on 4th Street at its intersection with Berry Court. (See Exhibit "A");
 - Oak Street toward Berry Court by erecting a "DEAF CHILD AREA" sign on 4th Street at its intersection with Oak Stree. (See Exhibit "A")

III. ERECTION OF "DEAF CHILD AREA" SIGN

- A. A "DEAF CHILD AREA" sign shall be erected on 4th Street at its intersection with Berry Court to warn vehicular traffic traveling on 4th Street from Berry Court toward Oak Street. (See Exhibit "A" for approximate location of "DEAF AREA CHILD" sign.)
- B. A "DEAF CHILD AREA" sign shall be erected on 4th Street at its intersection with Oak Street to warn vehicular traffic traveling on 4th Street from Oak Street toward Berry Court. (See Exhibit "A" for approximate location of "DEAF AREA CHILD" sign.)
 - A minimum of two "DEAF CHILD AREA" signs shall be erected on 4th Street to warn vehicular traffic traveling in the 100 Block of 4th Street of the presence of a deaf child.
