

**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF EAST CONEMAUGH, COUNTY OF
CAMBRIA, AND COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA CLARIFYING THE
INTENT AND SPIRIT OF ORDINANCE NO. ~~14-02~~ ADOPTED ON MAY 5, 2014,
BY EAST CONEMAUGH BOROUGH COUNCIL THAT MOVING PERMIT SHALL BE
PROCURED FOR THE MOVEMENT OF HOUSEHOLD GOODS AND PERSONAL
PROPERTY IN BULK FOR THE PURPOSE OF RELOCATING A PERSON'S
RESIDENCE OR ABODE INTO, WITHIN, OR OUT OF THE BOROUGH OF EAST
CONEMAUGH**

ORDINANCE NO. 14-03

WHEREAS, East Conemaugh Borough Council adopted Ordinance No. ~~14-02~~, on May 5, 2014, requiring a Moving Permit for either the removal or transportation of either Personal Property or Household Goods to or from any Real Estate in East Conemaugh Borough; and

WHEREAS, Ordinance No. ~~14-02~~ defines Personal Property or Household Goods as:

"PERSONAL PROPERTY or HOUSEHOLD GOODS - any tangible property that is the subject of ownership and is possible of being moved, and which is generally used in the operation of a business or for the maintenance of the household.

- (1) Family automobiles, recreation vehicles, including boats, campers, snow mobiles, and the like, or vehicles used in the operation of any business shall not be included in the definition of Personal Property or Household Goods."

WHEREAS, individuals present at the May 5, 2014, meeting of East Conemaugh Borough Council questioned if a moving permit was required for the movement of certain purchases such as televisions, automobiles, furniture, appliances and the like into, within, or out of the Borough of East Conemaugh; and


WHEREAS, East Conemaugh Borough Council stated the it was the spirit and intent of Ordinance No. ~~14-02~~ adopted on May 5, 2014, to require moving permits for a Person as the word "Person" is defined by Ordinance No. ~~14-02~~ to obtain a moving permit when that Person transports as the words "Transport" or "Transportation" are defined by Ordinance No. ~~14-02~~ in bulk for the purpose of changing a residence or abode.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that Borough Council adopts a fee of Five Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$5.00) for a moving permit; and


NOW THEREFORE, this 5th day of May, 2014, the Borough Council adopts the foregoing resolution setting the fee for a moving permit for Persons moving into, within, or out of the Borough at Five Dollars and 00/100 cents (\$5.00); and






